

10 SAFETY PRACTICES FOR IMAGING SERVICES TEAMS

The Antioch Imaging Services team in Northern California eliminated patient-lifting and other workplace injuries by building safety into everyday work processes. Here's how:

For all unit-based team members

- 1 Assess whether assistance is needed before transferring or repositioning hospital patients.
- 2 Always perform difficult imaging procedures in pairs.
- 3 Ask for help when needed to safely complete difficult imaging procedures.
- 4 Call a timeout until help arrives.
- 5 Report unsafe conditions to a manager or safety leader immediately.
- 6 Encourage departments to develop their own "safety always" rules and principles.

For co-leads and sponsors

- 7 Get agreement from other departments to assist with lifting patients when additional help is needed.
- 8 Create a peer recognition program to honor and reward team members seen performing their duties safely.
- 9 Conduct safety rounds. Ask individual workers about their concerns and build trust by addressing them promptly.
- 10 Distribute a quarterly newsletter with safety alerts and tips to all members of all shifts.
