This UBT increased the percentage of patients whose blood pressure was under control by:

- Calling each hypertensive patient with the message that their doctor is concerned, instead of sending a letter about blood pressure readings.
- Allowing patients to pop in almost any time for free mini-checks, which never take long.
- Bringing a doctor into the mini-check when a patient's blood pressure reads too high.
 The doctor discusses treatment options and urges the patient to return for a follow-up appointment within two weeks.
